



**Society Garlic**  
*Tulbaghia violacea*

Delightful small plant with blue-green grassy foliage and dainty lilac flowers on tall slender stems. Lovely for ground cover plantings or something unusual for the kitchen garden (the leaves and flowers are edible). Resilient and far tougher than its pretty looks suggest.



**Lavender**  
*Lavandula stoechas*

Small evergreen shrub with strongly scented, grey-green foliage and large deep purple flower spikes. Flowers mainly during summer.



**Citronella Geranium**  
*Pelargonium 'Citronella'*

An upright, evergreen, tender perennial with deeply cut, crinkled and serrated, soft green leaves. Strongly scented, the pretty leaves exude a delicious, sharp citrus scent when bruised.



**Calendulas**  
*Calendula officinalis*

Commonly used for wounds, rashes, infection, inflammation, and many other conditions. However, there is no strong evidence to support calendulas for any use.



**Bush Basil**  
*Plectranthus graveolens*

Bush Basil is strongly aromatic and somewhat resembles basil, complimenting Mediterranean flavours like tomato and garlic, was traditionally used as a medicinal and ceremonial herb.



**Salt Bush**  
*Atriplex nummularia*

Excellent source of protein and contains beneficial calcium and trace minerals. It also contains 20% less sodium than table salt and is a rich source of antioxidants.
